The Dover Police Department would like to extend an invitation to our Second Annual Safe Trick-or-Treat event on Friday, October 27, 2017, held in conjunction with the Downtown Dover Partnership. This event will be held on Legislative Mall from 5:30pm-7:30pm and is a great opportunity for you to showcase your business while participating in a family-friendly community outreach event that drew in an estimated 6,000 attendees in 2016, our first year doing the event.

Our goal is to fill the streets surrounding Legislative Mall with police vehicles, fire apparatus, emergency response equipment, and displays from local businesses to provide a fun-filled experience for both children and adults. You are invited to distribute items and materials to market your business or organization. All we request is that you bring a minimum of 2000+ pieces of candy or other trick-or-treat giveaways (we highly recommend doubling that amount to 4,000). These items do not have to be candy. Other ideas include small toys, balls, toothbrushes, pencils, crayons, or other items that are appropriate for children that will be Trick-or-Treating (13 and under). 1-2 pieces of candy per child is sufficient, since we anticipate over 70 Trick-or-Treat stations this year.

By including you in our community outreach event, we hope to build strong relationships throughout our community and with the citizens we serve. The support of local businesses and organizations for events such as these only help our city grow stronger and make Dover a better and safer place to live, work, and raise our families.
